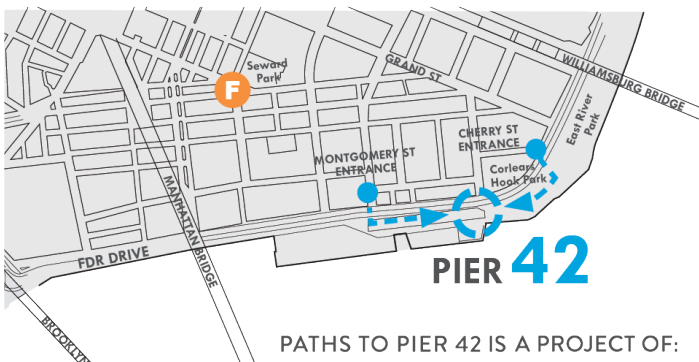
## SUMMER WATERFRONT CELEBRATION!
